## REGISTER ONLINE TO VOTE

- North Carolina offers online voter registration on the NC DMV website: [ncdot.gov/dmv](http://ncdot.gov/dmv)
- You will need:
  - A North Carolina driver's license or DMV-issued ID number AND a social security number
  - If you don't have these, you can still register by mail to vote on the NC Board of Elections website: [votebymail.ncsbe.gov](http://votebymail.ncsbe.gov)
- You can register online to vote until Friday, October 9, 2020.



## IMPORTANT DATES

<b>September 1</b>	Absentee Ballots start being mailed
<b>October 9</b>	Voter Registration Deadline
<b>October 15</b>	Early Voting Starts
<b>October 27</b>	Deadline to request absentee ballots
<b>October 31</b>	Last day of Early Voting
<b>November 3</b>	Election Day



## HOW TO REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT

- Fill out an official "**State Absentee Ballot Request Form**"
  - You can pick one up at your county board of elections office, download a copy from [NCSBE.gov](http://NCSBE.gov) OR request a ballot from [votebymail.ncsbe.gov](http://votebymail.ncsbe.gov)
- Return your completed "State Absentee Ballot Request Form" to your county board of elections office
  - You can submit your form by fax, email, mail OR drop it off in-person
- DEADLINE:** Your absentee ballot request must be received in the county board of elections office by **October 27, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.**
